

INTERNSHIP AGREEMENT

made in application of
 the student internship charter dated April 26, 2006

BETWEEN

- Ecole Nationale des Sciences Géographiques (ENSG)

represented by its current Director, hereafter designated as the « School »,

The Company Instituto Geográfico Português (Portuguese Geographic Institute)

- Rua Artilharia Um, 107 - sala 4.08, 1099 - 052 Lisboa, Portugal

represented by its current General Director hereafter designated as the « host company »,

- Vincent TOUPENSE, born on 27 April 1982 at Châtenay Malabry (92 near of Paris), student following the Engineering courses at ENSG, hereafter designated as the "trainee".

IT HAS BEEN AGREED AS FOLLOWS :

Article 1 – Aim of the agreement

The present agreement concerns the internship to be undertaken within the context of the Engineering courses at ENSG. Its aim is to define working conditions and terms of conduct in the trainee's host company.

Article 2 – Aim of the internship

The internship is obligatory and forms an integral part of the curriculum of the Engineering courses at ENSG. The host company promises to entrust to the trainee only those tasks which will contribute to this training and education in the broadest sense: to acquire skills or knowledge, practical or methodological.

Article 3 – Internship Program

This internship, taking place in the host company, deals with the following subject (validated by the School's professional training counselor, Mr Olivier Dissard, study director :

- Image classification.

The work entrusted to the trainee consists in doing a work of image classification. It comprising the whole process of cartographic production for one of the three study areas. The steps and schedule associated with the work to be developed in the training are acquaintance with RSU, software learning (ERDAS, PCI Geomatics, ArcGIS), selection of the training areas, selection of the image classifier, image classification, Final map validation and final report.

Article 4 – Supervision of trainee

An internship training supervisor is appointed by the host company : Mário Caetano to guide the trainee within the host company

A tutor is appointed by the School: Olivier.De-joinville to guide the trainee through any tasks required by the School.

Article 5 – Length and place of internship

The internship will begin on 11 June 2007 ; it will finish on 07 September 2007.

It will take place at Instituto Geográfico Português (Portuguese Geographic Institute)

Rua Artilharia Um, 107 - sala 4.08, 1099 - 052 Lisboa, Portugal ; it may eventually involve the trainee travelling into the field or for any other justified reason.

Article 6 – Trainee's status

The trainee, during his/her entire internship, retains his/her status as both student and trainee of the school.

During the internship, the ENSG's administration may request the trainee to participate in any publicity campaign organized by the School (symposium, exhibition...). This participation cannot, under any circumstances, exceed 2 working days.

Article 7 – Health insurance

During the entire internship, the trainee continues to be covered by the civil service's health insurance.

Article 8 – Civil liability

The trainee certifies that he/she has subscribed to an individual insurance policy covering civil liability during the internship.

The ENSG of IGN will under no circumstances be responsible for contracting such an insurance in the trainee's name in order to provide coverage of the trainee during the internship.

The host company certifies that it is ensured for civil liability according to the terms of the law currently in force.

Article 9– Work accidents

In application of article L. 412.8.2.b of the new health insurance code, the trainee's internship is governed by the legislation on work accidents, for accidents occurring within the facilities of the host company or while travelling along the trainee's route to and from his/her place of residence and the host company.

Article 10 – Pratical internship logistics

The trainee can recive no complementary remunerations. However, this restriction does not include indemnities for coats and expenses the trainee incurs from the exercise of his duties.

The trainee is responsible for covering his/her costs of food and lodging.

The training costs arising from the internship are covered by the host company, especially additional travel costs.

Article 11 – Discipline

During the internship, the trainee is required to respect the authority of the host company, especially insofar as working hours are concerned.

In case of disciplinary problems, the host company reserves the right to terminate the internship, after having informed the School.

The trainee agrees to respect a strict obligation of confidentiality on all the information concerning the host company that he or she may come to know within the course of the internship.

Article 12 – Evaluation of the trainee's work

At the end of the internship, the trainee will submit to the supervisor, the advisor and tutor designated above in article 4, a report on the work carried out and the results obtained.

After the completion of the internship, the School's tutor will invite the host company's supervisor to attend the trainee's defense presentation before an academic jury as a member of that panel in order to attribute a mark on the internship.

If unable to participate, the host company's internship training supervisor will address a confidential written report on the trainee's work to the School, especially with respect to fulfilling predetermined objectives. This evaluation will be accompanied by a mark on the internship.

Article 13 – Ownership of results

Ownership of results, especially in the form of computer software and reports the trainee will be led to work on during his/her internship (except if explicitly stated) remains the property of the host company and subject to its rules of ownership.

Article 14 – Legal Arbitration

Any difference between the parties arising from the interpretation or implementation of the present agreement which cannot be resolved out of court will be submitted to the jurisdiction of the competent court in Paris.

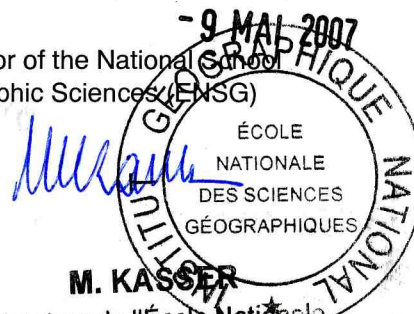
